New Chlorine Filling Station

A chlorine production plant in the UK has opened a new chlorine filling station. This facility fills small 100 kg cylinders from a three line filling bay. The filled cylinders are distributed around the UK from this site. Hunt & Mitton Actuated and Manual Bellows Seal Globe Valves were chosen for the isolation and filling processes of the new facility with over 50 valves that are now operating in this new station. We supplied technical application assistance, full certification and all valves were delivered on schedule to enable the on time start up.











New Chlorine Production Plant for Akinsan Kimya



In the Adana region of southern Turkey a new chlorine production plant is being built by our new customer Akınsan Kimya Sanayi ve Ticaret Anonim Sirketi. Their new plant will produce 29,000 tonnes per year of chlorine which will benefit thousands of people living in the region by purification of the water for the distribution system. The new plant will employ over 100 staff to manage the production of the chlorine and is scheduled to start production later this year. Akinsan Kimya selected a total of 69 Hunt and Mitton bellows seal manual isolation, straight through and angle pattern valves for their chlorine process lines. This is the first of a number of new chlorine plants that Akinsan Kimya will build over the next five years. We welcome them as a new customer and look forward to working with them on their additional plants in the future.
